The Agricultural Incubator Community Gardens

The Agricultural Incubator Foundation (AIF) is offering community garden plots for the 2021 season. Both conventional and organic plots are available. Plots range in size from 10' x 30' to 26' x 96'. Water and a community garden shed are provided. Plots will be assigned on a first come, first served basis.

COMMUNITY GARDENER PARTICIPANTS MUST ABIDE BY THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES:

As an AIF Community Garden participant, I will:

1. Attend posted garden meetings. Advanced notice will be given once gardens are assigned.
2. Garden organically If I am assigned an organic plot! (No till beyond initial prep, no chemical insecticides/herbicides or synthetic fertilizers are to be used.)
3. Plant a designated portion of my garden with produce for the local food banks.
4. Plant my garden before June 10.
5. Keep my weeds under control.
6. Keep my plot neat. If my plot becomes unkempt, I understand I will be given 1 weeks' notice to clean it up. After that time, it will be reassigned.
7. Respect my neighboring gardens; pick only my own crops.
8. Install fencing properly and securely (Fencing is optional).
9. Clean & put away any tools borrowed from the Community Garden shed.
10. Attend to watering & sprinkling, treat hoses carefully & wind them up to faucet site.
11. Harvest my garden & not allow produce to rot.
12. Pick up trash, litter & greenhouse plastic to take home for disposal.
13. Be responsible for behavior, supervision of any guests or children that I bring to the gardens & assure that they follow the guidelines and property of others.
14. Follow the no smoking and no alcoholic beverages rules of this property.
15. Arrange for family, friends, or neighboring gardeners to water, weed & harvest my garden if I am out of town or need help.
16. Perform a fall clean-up following AIF guidelines at the end of the season.
